Dear Saints,

We would like to fellowship with you regarding the Lord's move in Iceland.

Based on some visits to Iceland by a US brother, a seeking Icelandic brother was contacted in 2011 and invited to attend a conference in London that year. Subsequently, some brothers in the churches in Norway and Sweden picked up a burden to fellowship with him regularly on Skype. This brother and his wife attended a number of Nordic conferences and are continuing their fellowship with us. Then in 2020 a group of brothers began to pray consistently and definitely for the Lord's interest in Iceland in a weekly way. After the Covid-19 pandemic in 2022, five brothers mainly from UK and one from the US went for a week to have "boots on the ground" and see how people respond to the gospel. We mainly focused on two universities there but also distributed Recovery Version Bibles on the streets and made some contacts with a few Christian pastors and left a few Bibles with them. The results were very encouraging, and we saw the Lord's blessing.

The Icelandic prayer group presented this positive experience of what the Lord is doing in Iceland to the leading brothers of the Nordic countries (Norway, Sweden, Denmark, and Finland) in their semiannual meeting in Helsinki in February 2023. There was a definite and practical response from the brothers, who agreed to establish an Iceland gospel account in the church in Grimstad in Norway, where the Nordic churches can contribute financially to support follow-up visits for the gospel in Iceland. So far, this Iceland account has supported three trips of groups of saints to Iceland for distribution of Recovery Version Bibles, for visitation and shepherding of the local saints, as well as for contacting new ones.
